A harlequin set of six late 19th century fruitwood Sussex chairs, possibly by Morris & Co, comprising two carvers and four standards, height of carver 84cm, width of carver 53cm.

### Condition Report

2327 - The chairs all have some minor woodworm, which appears to be old and not active. There are three of the standard chairs that have slightly more substantial old worm to certain parts, including back spindles and bases of legs. Some have had the seat side rails replaced and there is wear to some of the seats. They are all fairly stable. One of the carvers, which has later screws holding the armrests on, is definitely ash, but the rest of the set appears to be some sort of fruitwood, as they do not look like ash, beech or walnut.
