A late 19th/early 20th century Louis Vuitton travelling trunk with overall monogram and quatrefoil decorated canvas covering, the corners and edges with applied metal mounts, the linen-lined interior fitted with two removable trays, bearing maker's stamp and numbered '121 319', height 59cm, width 90cm, depth 53cm (some overall typical surface wear and lacking one castor).

Estimate: £2,000 - £4,000

Condition Report

2520. Overall typical surface wear, with some scuffs, marks and scratches to the canvas. The underside is missing one castor, but also has some slight loss to the wooden straps. There is an overall light scattering of woodworm to the underside and sides which accounts for the majority of the visible dots that can be seen in the photographs, however there are also some black ink spots to the front. The metalwork has overall dents and some light surface rust, and the trunk is clearly lacking its leather straps.
