A Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jar, Qing dynasty, probably Kangxi period, the ovoid body painted with a continuous stem of alternating flowers and leaves between ruyi head and lappet borders, unmarked, height 21cm, together with a hardwood cover with pierced shou medallion top.

## Condition Report

1085. Generally good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration. Typical light surface scratches to glaze and tiny nick to footrim. Under UV light there are some small glaze star hairlines visible to the interior of the jar, but none of these come through to the exterior, they are simply interior glaze hairlines.

Wood cover in generally good order with some minor nicks/chips
