A Chinese mother-of-pearl, hardstone and bone inlaid hardwood rectangular trunk on stand, late Qing dynasty, the top decorated with a figural panel flanked by two vase shaped floral panels within a mother-of-pearl hemispherical border, the front with a similar figural panel, the sides and back with mother-of-pearl foliate decoration, the stand with a single drawer, width 90.5cm, height 74cm, depth 45.5cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

1305. Overall the trunk is in generally good condition. The vast majority of inset stones are present, but there are some minor losses and some chipped pieces of mother-of-pearl, along with some minor replacements to inlay.
