Condition Report

1067. Pair of Kutani vases - in generally good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt, but nothing significant.

Satsuma vase - in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light glaze crazing. Typical wear to gilt and paintwork.
