A collection of fifteen mostly Chinese wood stands, late 19th and 20th century, some with carved and pierced decoration, including foliate, key fret and lotus detail, some raised on scroll feet, diameters ranging from 7.5cm to 19cm, together with two domed, carved and pierced wood covers (faults and repairs).

Condition Report

Rectangular topped stand - 16cm long, 7.8cm high, good condition.

Circular stand - key fret apron, diameter 19cm, height 7.2cm, the apron is split and re-glued.

Circular stand - carved foliate apron, diameter 18.5cm, height 7.2cm, generally in good condition, typical surface wear, scuffs etc.

Circular stand with five scroll legs - diameter 22.5cm, height 13.5cm, generally in good condition, typical scuffs, nicks and wear.

Circular stand with carved apron and five scroll legs - diameter 18.5cm, height 10cm, missing stretcher to connect legs, otherwise dirty and dusty but generally in good condition.

Pair of ebonised stands with 5 scroll legs - diameter 15.5cm, height 10.3cm, typical wear, one with minor repair to pierced apron, otherwise ok.

Oval stand, ebonised, length 22.5cm - dirty and dusty, repairs to rim, typical scuffs, nicks and wear.

Circular stand, diameter 10cm - dirty and dusty otherwise generally ok.

Circular stand, diameter 18cm - one foot missing, typical scuffs, nicks and wear.

Circular stand, diameter 9cm - typical scuffs and wear, otherwise ok.

Circular stand with 5 scroll supports, diameter 13.5cm, height 10cm, minor nicks, scuffs and wear, otherwise ok.

3 circular stands, diameters 13.5cm, 15cm and 19.5cm, all missing central sections.

Circular stand diameter 14.5cm, height 10.5cm, missing section of stretcher, scroll legs loose, scuffs and scratches.

Circular cover, diameter 13.2cm - generally in good condition but missing finial, small split to rim.

Circular cover, diameter 15.2cm - minor nicks and losses to pierced work and missing finial.
