A group of six Chinese jade and green hardstone carvings, late Qing dynasty and later, including a carved celadon jade fruit pendant with 14K gold mounted suspension loop, total length 6.6cm, and an archaistic zoomorphic pendant of curled dragon and phoenix form, length 10.2cm.

Condition Report

Archaistic dragon and phoenix, 22.9g - generally in good condition, with some minor scuffs to edges and a few minor nicks to tips of scrolls. No cracks or repairs, fairly uniform pale celadon colour with some white/cream inclusions.

Fruit pendant, 28g - in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs, typical light surface scratches.

Cicada pendant, 27.2g - tiny nick to tip of one wing, otherwise generally in good condition with only typical light surface scratches.

Small fruit and squirrel pendant, 15g- minor nick to stalk on lower section, otherwise in good condition with typical light surface scratches.

Basket, 30.3g - missing upper section and a couple of minor scuffs/chips to edges, but generally in good condition.

Large pendant, 132.8g - generally in good condition, a few minor nicks to edges, no significant damage or repairs, small hairline to one of the pierced stalks.
