Condition Report

Bluett - generally in ok condition but the cover is scuffed and worn, spine intact, some typical light spotting to interior pages.

Veiga - Dust jacket tired, ripped and sellotaped, Hard covers of book creased, otherwise ok with typical thumbed edges. Previously possibly stored in damp conditions.

Enamelled Wear - dust jacket badly ripped and sellotaped, otherwise typical light wear, some discolouration and spotting to edges of pages. Previously possibly stored in damp conditions.

Valenstein - in good condition overall, dust jacket tiny bit creased to edges.

Watson - In good condition overall with minor scuffs to edges.

Randall - In good condition.

Genius of China - generally in good condition, slightly discoloured edges.

Gascoigne - dust jacket with minor tears, creasing and scuffs, typical light staining to page edges.

Honey - typical scuffs to spine and edges, slight discolouration to page edges, otherwise ok.

Masterpieces in Wood - some pages with minor creasing.

Medley - generally in good condition, typical wear, creased back cover, slight discolouration to page edges.
