A Chinese Canton famille rose enameled celadon ground porcelain circular dish, mid to late 19th century, decorated with butterflies, fruit and flowers, diameter 25.8cm (two hairlines to rim), together with a pair of similar smaller dishes, diameter 18.2cm (minor rim chips), and a famille rose porcelain double snuff bottle, mark of Qianlong but late 19th/early 20th century, formed as two conjoined cylindrical bottles, painted with figures in landscapes, height 5.8cm (chipped and repaired rim).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1048. Larger dish - two hairlines to rim (2.5cm and 2cm long) and a few minor nicks to rim, typical light surface scratches and wear.

2 smaller dishes - both with minor nicks to rims and typical surface scratches and wear to enamels, one slightly worse than other. No cracks or repairs.

Double snuff bottle - section of rim broken on one side and minor chips to rim of other side. Both with chips to footrim. Some wear to enamels.
