A string of ten Chinese carved coquilla nut beads, late Qing dynasty, each carved in the form of Buddha, each bead length approx 3.1cm, together with a Chinese Canton export ivory cylindrical beaker, mid-19th century, with opposing carved figural panels, height 8.8cm (missing base panel).

Condition Report

1318. Beads are all in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

The ivory beaker/shaker is in good condition with only a small natural shrinkage crack to base rim (1cm long), and no base.
