### LOT 1260

A Chinese pale celadon jade and hardstone set three-section pendant, late Qing dynasty, each section carved and pierced with shou characters and flowers beneath a band of prunus, length 11.8cm, height 5cm.

Estimate: £200 - £400

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### Condition Report

All 3 jade sections are in generally good condition. The colour is uniform and carving and piercing is good. No significant damage or repairs. There is a very small hairline to the left side panel where it is hinged, but it is of no real significance as it runs over 3 small pieces of the pierced work. The two upper hinges are missing their pins so are loose at present. The right side panel is missing 1 stone. The green stones are jade, we are not sure on the pink stones, but they appear to be rose quartz.

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
