A Chinese famille rose porcelain vase, Yongzheng style but late Qing dynasty, the shouldered tapering body and short flared neck painted with birds, butterflies and blossoming branches, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 43.2cm (reduced neck and small hairline to body).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

The vase is in generally good condition with good bright and vibrant decoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear but nothing significant. There is a faint hairline crack to the body which runs from just under the collar and vertically approx three quarters of the way down the vase.

The neck has been reduced and there are subsequently minor nicks around the ground down edge of the neck circumference.
