### LOT 1107

Two Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jars and covers, mark of Kangxi but late Qing dynasty, each ovoid body and cover painted with prunus, underglaze blue four-character mark to bases, heights 15.3cm and 14.2cm (one cover repaired), together with four Japanese Imari dishes, Meiji period, diameter 21.5cm, and an Arita blue and white scallop shell moulded dish, length 25cm (some faults).

### Condition Report

Jar one - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze. Cover in good condition.

Jar two - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze. Cover broken in two with numerous chips to rim.

Shell dish - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze.

4 Imari dishes - 2 generally in good condition with no chips or cracks, typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels. One of the dishes has a chip to the rim approx 3 by 0.5cm and typical wear to gilt and enamels. The other dish with 4cm hairline to rim and wear to gilt and enamels.
