### LOT 1264

A Chinese blue and white porcelain bottle vase, mark of Xuande but late Qing dynasty, painted with birds and blossoming branches, underglaze blue four-character mark to base, height 20cm (chip to footrim), together with a Chinese white glazed soft paste porcelain bottle vase, late Qing dynasty, with globular body and narrow cylindrical neck, covered in lightly crackled creamy white glaze, height 30cm (minor faults), and a circular wood stand, diameter 16cm.

Estimate: £70 - £100

### Condition Report

Blue and white vase - chip to footrim, otherwise in good condition with no cracks or restoration.

White glazed vase - firing crack across footrim approx 6.5cm total length, also a couple of overglazed manufacturing chips to footrim, otherwise the rest of the vase in generally good condition with typical light crazing and some small areas of staining/discolouration.

Stand - in generally good condition, some wear to the polish.
