A collection of Chinese porcelain, 19th century and later, including a cylindrical vase painted with fish and crab, height 20cm (repaired and chipped rim), three blue and white vases, famille verte crackle glazed vase, height 20.5cm, a famille rose cylindrical teapot painted with red and black characters above mandarin ducks on a lotus pond, iron red painted seal mark to base, height 7.8cm (lacking cover), and a famille verte ginger jar, height 12cm (some faults).

Condition Report

Vase with fish and crab - there is a broken out section of rim which has been re-glued approx 4 by 1cm and another small rim repair to the other side, otherwise generally in good order with typical light surface scratches and wear.

Blue and white baluster vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Yellow and blue spittoon - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Famille verte crackle glaze vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Famille verte ginger jar - small firing crack to rim, otherwise in good condition.

Blue and white baluster vase - lacking cover, approx 4 by 2cm U-shaped section of rim missing, otherwise ok.

Smaller blue and white baluster vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Lacking cover.

Famille rose landscape vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light wear.

Teapot - Lacking cover, otherwise generally in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Typical light wear to gilt and enamels.

Continental jar and cover - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Soapstone boy on buffalo - in good condition.
