LOT 1322

A group of Chinese blue and white porcelain, late 19th century and later, all painted with prunus decoration, comprising a large jar and a cover, mark of Chenghua but late 19th century, height 35cm (repaired), a baluster vase and cover with ruyi head collar, height 38cm (repaired), three other smaller vases and four ginger jars and covers (mostly with faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

Large stout baluster jar and cover, 35cm - extensively broken into numerous pieces and re-glued with some overpainting and some filler to the rim, the cover with restoration and overpainting to the rim.

Large baluster jar and cover, 38cm - broken into numerous pieces and re-glued. Cover with repaired chip to rim.

Mid sized vase and cover, 26.5cm - chip and small hairline to rim, otherwise ok. Small chip to rim of cover.

Baluster vase, 17.5cm - broken into 3 pieces and repaired, lacking cover.

Small baluster vase and cover, 13.5cm - minor chips to rims of vase and cover, otherwise ok.

Larger ginger jar, 15.4cm - crack running horizontally approx halfway round body and small rim repair, cover broken into 3 pieces and repaired with minor rim chips.

Ginger jar, 14.3cm - crack to body running entire length of jar, cover broken and repaired.

Ginger jar, 11cm - starcrack to body, minor rim repair and chips, cover broken in 2 and re-glued.

Ginger jar, 11cm - good condition.
