LOT 1323

A group of Chinese blue and white porcelain, late 19th century and later, all painted with blossoming prunus decoration, comprising a ginger jar and cover, height 25cm, a smaller ginger jar and cover, height 19cm, three other ginger jars, three baluster vases and two covers and a cylindrical cover (mostly with faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

Ginger jar, 25cm - fine crack to rim running vertically down the jar, approx 22cm long, otherwise only typical surface scratches and wear to glaze. Cover broken in two and re-glued.

Ginger jar, 19cm - Body in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The cover has a chip and hairline crack running from the rim approx 10cm into the centre of the cover

Ginger jar, 12.5cm - crack to body running horizontally two thirds of the way around the jar.

Ginger jar, 12cm - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. No cover.

Ginger jar, 12.5cm - broken in half horizontally and re-glued, no cover.

Large cylindrical cover - chip to rim and 6cm hairline.

Baluster prunus vase and cover, 31cm high - body broken into 4 pieces and re-glued, cover with numerous rim chips.

Prunus vase, 25.5cm - no cover, chip to rim, body broken into 5 pieces and re-glued. Glaze fritting around base.

Vase and cover, 27cm - chip to footrim, other minor nicks to footrim, otherwise body generally in good order, associated cover with repaired chip to rim.
