A Chinese hardwood low rectangular stand, late 19th /early 20th century, the panelled top raised on four short key fret feet united by a stretcher to each end, length 45.3cm, width 30.2cm, height 7cm, together with six other hardwood stands, including an example with pierced foliate apron, height 14cm and a pierced and carved dish stand, height 30.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Large rectangular stand - generally in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Square stand with carved and pierced apron - in good condition, typical light scuffs and wear.

Square tall stand - generally in good condition with typical wear and scuffs.

Small square stand - small nick to rim, otherwise ok with minor typical scuffs and wear.

Larger square stand - generally in good condition, typical wear and surface scratches.

Rectangular stand - generally in good condition with typical light wear and surface scratches.

Dish stand - generally in good condition, typical minor scuffs and wear, minor crack/split to piercing, a few minor nicks to pierced back.
