A group of five Chinese porcelain teabowls, 18th century and later, comprising two blue and white bowls, diameters 7.2cm and 10cm, two famille rose bowls and a later blue and white bowl, underglaze blue four-character mark to base, diameter 6.9cm (faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Blue and white dragon bowl - broken into 3 pieces and amateurishly repaired with minor losses along the break lines.

Blue and white teabowl with pine in fenced garden - section broken out and repaired, hairline crack, numerous rim chips.

Smallest blue and white bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Famille rose teabowl - 1.5cm hairline, rim chip and 4 cm hairline, 3cm hairline and a couple of other minor rim chips.

Smaller famille rose teabowl - 4cm hairline crack and minor nick to rim.
