A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vase, mid to late 19th century, of shouldered tapering form with flared neck, typically painted with panels of figures, birds, flowers and butterflies, height 35.2cm (crack to neck).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Small repair and chip to rim approx 2.5 by 2cm, with 2 hairline cracks emanating from this area, 7 and 2.5cm long.

Otherwise the body in generally good condition, typical wear to gilding particularly on applied dragons and lions.

Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.
