A Chinese blue and white porcelain jar and cover, 19th century, the baluster body and domed cover decorated in white enamel with birds flying amidst scattered flowers on a blue glazed ground, height 62cm (crack to body).

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

There is a restored crack running vertically almost the entire height of the vase, down from the rim approx 45cm in length, some minor overpainting along the crack.

There is a small 3mm drilled hole just to the left of this crack on the shoulder. There are 4 other drilled holes at evenly spaced intervals around the neck of the vase, and another 6 drilled holes to the cover (three to each side) - these holes seem to have no apparent reason for their presence.

Small restored chip to rim of cover, approx 2 by 3.5cm.
