A Chinese Tek Sing cargo blue and white lotus pattern bowl, circa 1820, of slightly flared circular form, diameter 15.4cm, bearing Nagel auctions label, together with a small group of Chinese porcelain including a Canton famille rose coffee cup and saucer and various provincial saucer dishes (some faults).

Condition Report

1302. Tek Sing bowl - small chip to rim, typical crazing to glaze and small firing crack to rim, otherwise in good order.

Green enamelled plate - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt.

Iron red enamelled plate - small chip and hairline to rim, typical wear.

Square dragon plate - generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light wear.

Larger saucer dish - good condition, minor surface scratches and wear.

9 smaller saucer dishes - in generally good order, a couple have minor rim chips and all have typical surface scratches and wear to enamels.

Canton cup and saucer - small hairline to saucer rim, otherwise good order with typical light surface wear to gilt and enamels.
