An early George III Cuban mahogany bureau bookcase, the dentil moulded pediment above a pair of arched panel doors, the sides with large brass handles, raised on bracket feet, height 213cm, width 114cm, depth 58cm.

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

2007. Two pieces of carved wooden moulding are loose, just below cornice. Leather writing panel has split in half where the flap folds down. Small losses to veneer, particularly noticeable on top and around base. Crack down left side of base. No signs of previous woodworm. Handles are possibly not original. General age related marks and wear. Both parts are original and the same colour.
