LOT 502

A late Victorian diamond pendant brooch, designed as a starburst, mounted with cushion and rose cut diamonds, width 4cm (one diamond lacking), with an associated case.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

One point of the starburst has been bent over, with the resultant loss of a cushion cut diamond which is no longer present.

The brooch has been later white metal plated.

The diamonds look to be attractive white stones, with only one or two inclusions.

Would benefit from careful professional cleaning.

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
