A late Victorian gold backed and silver set diamond brooch of pierced design, the central starburst motif set with variously cut diamonds within a quatrefoil shaped surround, further set with diamonds, fitted with a safety chain, weight 9.2g, width 3.2cm.

Condition Report

The diamonds are attractive white stones, with one or two inclusions but are generally attractive bright diamonds.

The brooch pin is rather wobbly.

There is a loop at the back of the bottom of the brooch, which at one time perhaps held a drop. Overall condition is good.

Principal diamond carat weight approx. 0.50ct

The surrounding eight diamonds to the principal diamond are probably approx. 0.12ct each. .

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
