LOT 580

A gold, diamond, pink gem and black enameled ring, collet set with the principal cushion cut diamond on a black enameled ground between opposing palmette motifs, mounted with alternating rows of rose cut diamonds and pink gems, between split scrolled shoulders, unmarked, weight 2.5g, ring size approx Q, with an associated case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

The diamonds generally have a few inclusions.

The pink gems have one or two inclusions, there is slight variation of colour to them.

The black enameled decoration to the centre has been redone.

Lead solder visible at the back securing the mounting of the principal diamond into position. There is a repair visible at the back at one shoulder.

Suggested origin Continental Europe, second half of the 19th century.

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
