### LOT 657

A gold and diamond five stone ring, circa 1900, mounted with a row of graduated cushion cut diamonds, the mount decorated with scroll pierced sides, detailed '18', weight 4.4g, ring size approx K.

Estimate: £400 - £500

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### Condition Report

The diamonds generally slightly draw colour to grey. There have one or two inclusions.

Small fracture chip down the side of the principal diamond.

The second diamond in on one end has an inclusion which is surface reaching, from the top to the bottom of the stone. There is also a fracture chip on the opposing side on this diamond.

The ring is quite dirty and these inclusions might become more evident once cleaned.

Only two diamond points survive. Six further diamond points are lacking.

There is some wear to each side of the ring as a result on contact with other rings.

Length of top of ring approx. 18mm, width of top of ring approx. 4mm.

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
