An Edwardian gold, rose cut diamond and enamelled stickpin in the form of a racehorse and jockey, the horse mounted with a cabochon ruby eye, otherwise mounted with cushion and rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 3.3g, with a base metal security clip and a Garrard & Co case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

### Condition Report

Slight chip to the enamel of the jockey's boot. Two or three chips at the back of the jockey, mostly to his coat and trousers.

The diamonds slightly draw colour, with slight variation of cut, one or two have surface reaching inclusions. Bottom of pin slightly bent.

Overall a nice piece in fairly good condition.

Length of race horse approx. 20mm, height of race horse approx 9mm.

Case in good condition.
