A pair of George III silver Neoclassical candlesticks, each removable square nozzle above an urn shaped sconce, raised on a fluted tapered column and square base with swagged decoration, Birmingham 1779, possibly by William Wright, height 26.7cm.

Condition Report

345. Both candlesticks in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Both a little bit tired with typical light surface scratches and some light wear to highpoints of decoration. As can be seen in the online images, they stand nice and straight. Hallmarks are good and clear with only minor rubbing. Nozzles have part lion passant marks to them and fit well. Very minor misshaping which is easily sorted, one has a small tear where the drip tray meets the socket, but not obviously noticeable.
