### LOT 2428

A collection of 18th and 19th century glass scent bottles, including two coloured glass bottles of elongated square form with gilt decoration, height 17.5cm, a foliate painted opaque glass scent bottle in the form of a hand, height 10.5cm, a cut glass scent bottle and stopper of oval form, height 13.5cm (lacking top), and various other glass scent bottles (mostly lacking tops).

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### Condition Report

Blue glass bottle - in good condition with only some minor wear to the pewter lid and collar.

Milk glass hand - has what looks like a rough pontil mark on the top of the fingers and some dents and wear to edges of the pewter.

Green Oxford lavender - some minor wear to the gilt and a tiny flea bit nibble to the bottom edge.

Blue Oxford - some minor wear to gilt.

Later blue glass scent - some wear to lid.

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
