An early Victorian silver mounted aide-mémoire, the front and back engraved with foliate scrolls, fitted with a propelling pencil and suspension chain, Birmingham 1839 by Taylor & Perry, height 8cm, and a silver cigarette case with engraved decoration, Birmingham 1923, weight 49g, length 8cm.

Condition Report

307 - Aide-mémoire in generally good order, typical light surface scratches and wear to engraving. Minor misshaping to edges of silver panels. Hallmarks slightly rubbed/worn. Pencil fits well and holds together tightly. Leather spine and interior in generally good order with typical wear.

Cigarette case with dents to back corners, also typical wear. Hinge ok. Good clear hallmarks.
