### Condition Report

357 - Five wishbone holders with typical surface scratches and wear, some minor misshaping and most have small lead repairs where wishbone meets arch at the base, some more obvious than others. Good clear hallmarks.

Other two in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear marks.
