A Continental gold, silver set, diamond and enamelled circular brooch, last quarter of the 19th century, designed as a bird with enamelled and rose cut diamond set feathers, with an enamelled and diamond set foliate spray applied to circlet, unmarked, weight 10.3g, width 3.6cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £1,500 - £1,700

Condition Report

535 - The brooch is in generally good condition with no significant damage. The enamel work has some minor chips and losses and some minor repairs. Rosecut diamonds are bright and sparkly with some typical inclusions visible under magnification. Gold mounts with typical surface scratches and wear.

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
