A pair of early 19th century percussion belt pistols by Braggs, 13 High Holborn, London, with octagonal turn-off barrels, barrel length 9cm, each with foliate-decorated lock and hammer, swing-over hinged ramrod, chequered grip and steel butt cap with hinged percussion cap holder (losses to both hammers, overall wear, losses and light rust), together with a later oak gun box.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1878. Both guns lock and dry fire, one gun locks a half and full cock, one does only at full cock. Both hammers have damage, as can be seen in the images on our website. The captive ram-rods stay secure in their parked positions.
