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A gold, rose cut diamond and enamelled brooch in the form of a racehorse and jockey, mid-20th century, the horse mounted with a cabochon ruby eye, otherwise mounted with circular cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 4.5g, width 3.4cm.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

The circular cut diamonds have one or two piqué inclusions. The brooch is overall a little dirty. Jockey's hand does not quite meet the reign. Evidence of lead solder securing the jockey to the horse is visible when viewed from the back. Hinge pin a little loose.

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
