## **Condition Report**

The chains to the drops are both rather worn. The glazing and frame of the small oval locket at the back is missing. Small dent at the top of the bow. Hinge bracket possibly replaced. The three blue gems on the left side of the brooch are paste replacements, the central one of these is chipped. One or two other turquoise have perhaps been replaced in the past.

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
