An early Victorian gold foil backed garnet and half-pearl set brooch, circa 1840, in a cruciform design with bead and wirework decoration, unmarked, weight 7.1g, width 3.9cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

The right hand side is missing a pearl and the mounting to accommodate the pearl. The garnet here has one or two chips. On the opposing side there is some wirework lacking. The pearl mounted at the top is slightly twisted over in its setting. One of the principal pearls has been pushed down in its mount. The brooch fittings at the back are later replacements, with the use of lead solder at one end.
