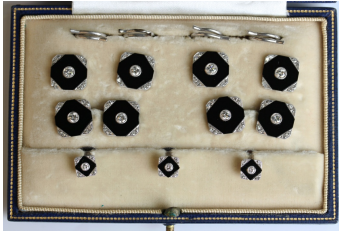

An 18ct white gold, diamond and black onyx dress set, comprising a pair of cufflinks, four buttons and three studs, each cut cornered square front centred by a circular cut diamond on a black onyx ground with diamond set two stone corners, Birmingham 1963, by Cropp & Farr Ltd, weight 19.5g, with a Wartski Limited case.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

In overall good condition.

Only one or two of the tiniest nicks/scratches to the onyx, these only noticeable under a 10x loupe.

Diamonds have one or two small inclusions but are generally attractive bright sparkling stones. One or two do draw colour to yellow.

All pieces are hallmarked, with same maker and same date letter.
