An 18ct white gold, sapphire and diamond cluster ring, claw set with the principal circular cut diamond within a surround of six circular cut sapphires, with six further smaller circular cut diamonds mounted to the border, weight 3.8g, London 1974, ring size approx N1/2.

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

Sapphires are of dark colour saturation, under bright light a number of inclusions can be seen.

One sapphire has a chip to the girdle/top edge of the stone which is noticeable without magnification. One or two other sapphires have minor scratches/nicks to facets/facet edges, only really noticeable under magnification.

Diamonds slightly draw colour to yellow. Principal diamond appears to be fairly clear internally, the surround diamonds have one or two inclusions.

Resized in the past.

Hallmark slightly rubbed.
