Condition Report

Opals have an attractive play-of-colour, predominantly in shades of blue/green.

Minor rubbing to the surface of the opals. One side opal has a small chip to the very edge/underside, which is noticeable under 10x magnification but is in a position which it is not noticeable when viewed from above. One or two claws are showing some signs of wear around the opals, it would be recommended to have them retipped to ensure security of the stones.

Diamonds have a few inclusions.

Typical light surface scratching to the shank.

Would benefit from a clean.

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
