R', chequered walnut grip and steel butt cap with hinged percussion trap, with associated leather holster.

Condition Report

1871. Overall wear and scratches, some heavier than others. Small amount of blueing remaining. Some heavy pitting, tool marks around the beginning of the barrel and the front of the cylinder. Trigger guard, cylinder and butt plates show old signs of rust and cleaning. Section to top of wooden grip missing, 1cm x 1cm. Action works smoothly.
