An Edwardian gold, amethyst and seed pearl pendant of hexagonal snowflake form, the central hexagonal step cut amethyst within a ropetwist border, with an outer border of seed pearl set trefoil shaped motifs and a seed pearl set suspension loop, unmarked, weight 4.9g, length 2.8cm, with a gold twin bar and oval link neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '15', weight 2g, length 42.5cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

One pearl section has been slightly bent down. The hinge which is directly below this has been bent to one side and is keeping the pin in the fastened position, this would need to be straightened to allow it to be worn as a brooch.

Pearls have an attractive lustre.

Chain in generally good condition.

Would benefit from a clean.
