LOT 659

A small group of jewellery, including a Chinese gilt metal and coral bead multiple row bracelet, length 18cm, a matching pair of dress clips and a pair of earstuds, each with beaded decoration, a Scottish silver circular brooch with a central lion motif, Edinburgh 1956, various other brooches and an amber bead.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

Coral bracelet - five rows of coral beads are single rows compared to the majority which are multiple rows, suggesting some losses in the past. The stringing generally is extremely fragile and would need to be redone to ensure security of the item for wear.

Coral dress clips - clip fastening to one clip is slightly bent, otherwise ok

Coral earrings - the stringing to one earring is starting to fail resulting in coral beads detaching, there is a small bag of loose beads accompanying the lot as a result. This same earring has a detached but present screw fitting.

Triangular dress clip - noticeable chip to the top right of the central stone.

Pointed filigree brooch - bent pin and side

Leaf brooch - bent in a few places at the edges

Other pieces in the lot are in generally good condition.

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
