LOT 666

A pair of gold, diamond, turquoise and seed pearl pendant earrings, each with a seed pearl and turquoise cluster drop surmounted by a further turquoise and a cushion cut diamond, with wire fittings, unmarked, weight 3.6g, length 2cm.

Estimate: £140 - £180

Condition Report

The diamonds have a few inclusions but are fairly bright white stones.

The pearls have an attractive silvery lustre.

Turquoise fairly even in colour and in generally good condition.

On one earring there is a small split to the loop attaching the diamond surmount to the top turquoise

Would benefit from a clean.

Suggested age - difficult to say, the condition generally is very good possibly suggestive of a later manufacture, rather than say Victorian/Edwardian.

We have not tested the earrings, they appear to have a gilt flashing to the backs, but possibly are better than 9ct.
