55. Some age toning and light browning to paper. A few minor spots of staining caused by detritus trapped beneath the glass. Some minor paint flaking to the tail of the jacket and trousers. The work has not been laid down. Slightly loose in frame.

Frame with chips to three corners and other nibbles to the edge, otherwise condition of frame commensurate with age.
