## LOT 542

A gold, opal and diamond heart shaped pendant, early 20th century, claw set with the heart shaped opal within a surround of twelve graduating cushion cut diamonds, with a diamond set three stone suspension loop, unmarked, weight 2.4g, length 2.6cm, with a gold oval link neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '9c', weight 1.6g, length 40.2cm, together with a purchase receipt, dated '27.4.1928'.

Estimate: £400 - £600

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## Condition Report

Opal approx. 8mm x 7mm

Pleasing play-of-colour, largely in the green/blue shades.

Principal diamond has a couple of chips to the table/table facet edge.

Diamonds generally have a few inclusions, some of which are surface reaching. They generally draw colour to grey.

A couple of the claws to the diamonds are showing signs of wear, they may need re-tipping fairly soon.

Total diamond weight difficult to ascertain due to setting but approx. 0.60-0.70ct.

Chain in generally good condition.

Would benefit from a clean.

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
