A silver cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch with gilt lever movement, the backplate detailed 'A Yewdall, Leeds 92442', with a dust cover, the signed enamelled dial with black Roman numerals and subsidiary seconds, Chester 1909, case diameter 5.6cm, with a key and base metal watch chain, together with a silver cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch with unsigned jewelled lever movement, the silver inner and outer case interiors detailed '0,935', the inner case exterior detailed 'Examined by J.W. Benson', the enamelled dial with black Roman numerals and subsidiary seconds, case diameter 4.9cm, with a silver circular link watch Albert chain and key.
