A mid-19th century brass skeleton timepiece with eight day single fusee movement, the silvered chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'John Woolrich Wolverhampton', the cross frame with turned pillars, height 29cm, mounted on a wooden base, with pendulum (lacking glass dome).

1114. The clock is in cosmetically generally good order with typical wear to frame and chapter ring. The movement appears to be complete, but the fusee chain is slack/unraveled. No glass dome.
