A mid-19th century French Paris porcelain mantel clock and stand with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the circular enamel dial with blue Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Potonié Paris', the case of rococo scroll moulded form with gilt decoration, painted with flowers and encrusted with further flowers and bees, total height 42.7cm, with pendulum (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1164. The clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The porcelain case has a couple of chips/losses to ends of scrolls and minor chips to a few encrusted leaves and petals. Typical minor rubbing to gilt. Stand in generally good order with typical minor wear to gilt and minor chips to petals. Dial is chipped around winding holes. The movement winds, but the clock does not run.
