A mid-19th century French Paris porcelain mantel clock and stand with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the circular enamel dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Malecot a Paris', the green ground case of rococo scroll moulded form with gilt decoration, height 40cm, with pendulum and key, together with a similar porcelain mantel clock, encrusted with flowers, height 3.5cm, with pendulum and key (restoration and other minor faults).

Condition Report

1165. Green glazed case - in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical wear to gilt and small repair to top scroll. Stand in similar condition. Dial cracked and chipped. The clock does not run. Blue case - some restoration to scrolls and minor chips to flowers. Dial is cracked and dirty. The clock does not run.
